The railways estimated it would take six months to repair the sole link between mainland India and Rameshwaram. Sreedharan did it in just 46 days. A legend was born. But significant as it was, even this wasn't a turning point in his life. "I had a very ordinary, uneventful career in the Indian Railways from December 1954 to June 1990. No doubt, restoration of the Pamban bridge gave me an excellent opportunity to demonstrate my technical and organisational competence. But it wasn't a turning point in my career'. What was it then? Sreedharan says it was a stirring article in Reader's Digest, which highlighted the need for 'out-of-the-box' thinking when faced with a major challenge. He was then Member (Engineering) on the Railway Board in 1990. It so happened that the senior railway engineer, in what seemed like the last phase of his career, was facing what appeared to be an insurmountable challenge. Railways minister George Fernandes had mentioned his dream project, a Mumbai to Mangalore railway line that would complete India's last great missing rail link.
