3 to 5 Years



MAGIC PAINTING

Materials Required

- 1 A4 white sheet
- 2 White crayon
- 3 Diluted light blue paint
- 4 One thick paint brush

Objectives

- 1 LANGUAGE:
 - To develop phonemic awareness.
 - To use sentences to describe what is observed.
- 2 PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:
 - To develop fine motor.
- 3 CREATIVE EXPRESSIONS:
 - To explore art tools.

Let's play

What to do?

- On an A4 sheet, parent to draw a rainy season scene, using a white crayon only.
- Things that can be drawn are a child holding an umbrella, raindrops, frog, mushroom, some puddles, peacock, child wearing gumboots.
- Since this drawing will be done with white crayon on a white paper, nothing will be visible to the child.
- The child must dip the brush in diluted light blue paint and paint the entire page.
- The wonder they experience on seeing the rainy scene coming to life is going to be fabulous!
- Once the activity is done do encourage the child to talk about what he/she saw in the painting.
- Get the child to name the things that are present in the painting.
- Get the child to count the number of things he can see in the painting. (number of frogs, number of snails, number of boots, how many puddles etc.)
- Ask the child what else he/she thinks could have been added to it.
- Ask the child if he/she feels it's nice or anything is missing in it.
- Allow the child to make his/her own drawing with the white crayon if he/she feels like it.
