3 to 5 Years

SHADE-N-SOUND

Requirements

- 1 A place where you are going to play this game
- 2 A drum/bell or other instrument to make a loud noise

Objectives

- 1 LANGUAGE:
 - To develop phonemic awareness.
 - To use sentences to describe what is observed.

- 2 MATH:
 - To do quantification, skip counting by 10s.

- 3 PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:
 - To enhance gross motor skills.

Let's play

What to do?

- Specify a place where you are going to play this game. Draw 4-5 circles there and write different sounds inside them.
- The "shady place" is a specific area you have laid out where you will be playing.
- Have a race to get in the shade! Talk to the children about the type of summer your area has.
- Keep a drum, a bell or other instrument to make a loud noise.
- When the sound is made, the children should "run to the place of shade."
- Then parent says a sound and the child jumps into the circle with the corresponding sound and gives a word or two, beginning with that sound.
- Choose the letters that the child needs practice in.
- You can add numbers too and get them to count numbers and skip counting by 10.
