Materials Required

- 1 A basket/tray/trolley
- 2 Miscellaneous objects from different parts of the house. (Make sure the child relates to them.)
- 3 One doll.

Objective

Making a connect between objects and where they belong.

Development of gross motor muscles.

Learning to follow simple instructions.

Learning the simple yet important skill of keeping things in order.

Let's play

What to do?

- 1 Collect miscellaneous objects in the basket/tray/trolley from different parts of the house. Make sure the child relates to them.
- 2 Sit in the living room.
- 3 Tell your child that Diana Doll has collected all these objects (pointing to the basket) and now does not know where to put them back.
- 4 Take one object at a time from the basket and ask the doll where it should go.
- 5 Keep having a conversation between Diana doll and your child and let them continue the conversation.
- 6 Allow the child to go to that room with the object and ensure that it is kept in the right place
- 7 Keep some things in the wrong place and wait for your child to place them in the correct place. (Keep the bucket in the living room corner, Keep the spoon in the bathroom etc.)
- 8 Continue this activity till all objects have been put back in their right places.
