

I spy with My eye

PARENT-LED
ACTIVITY

Objectives

- To identify the beginning sound of a word
- To associate sounds with their symbols
- To enrich vocabulary

Materials Needed

- A tray, some objects given in the table below, letter cards

Instructions

- Collect all objects or at least one object of each letter and spread them out on a tray.
- Start the activity by saying 'I spy with my eye something which begins with the sound 'j''
- Place the 'j' letter card on the floor and wait for the child to place the object which begins with the sound beside it.
- Do the same with one more sound.
- After that, place all the cards around the child and allow him to carry on with the activity.
- Parent to be the silent observer and help only when the child asks for help, not otherwise.
- If the child is interested, you can add more objects that the child is familiar with and accordingly add more cards to complete the activity.

j	Jug, jalebi, jar, jacket
z	Zip, picture or toy of zebra, zig zag line-cut out, zebra crossing
w	Wafer, watch, wallet
v	Vase, violet paper, vessel, some vegetables
q	Pictures of queen and quilt
y	Pictures of a yacht, yellow paper, yellow yarn or just any yarn, yam
