



Listen And Bounce Activity

Objectives

- To be aware of beginning and ending sounds in a word
- To enhance gross motor movements
- To enhance hand-eye coordination

Materials Needed

- A big ball which can be bounced and caught
- Chalk

Instructions

- Parent to make a list of some familiar words before the activity begins.
- The beginning sounds of these words to be written on the floor using chalk.
- As the parent calls out the word, the child will bounce the ball on the sound written on the floor and catch the ball.
- For example: If the parent calls out 'pumpkin', the child will bounce the ball on /p/ and catch the ball.
- The same can be repeated with ending sounds.
