Activities that the child can do on his/her own. Parents are welcome to join in if your child invites.



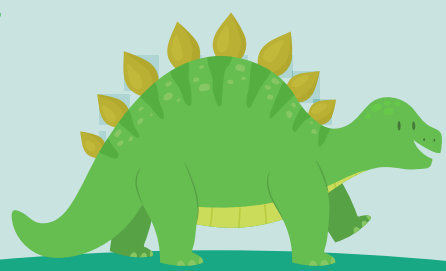
Activity involving some cleaning/handwash after it is done.
