Learning Objectives

- To reinforce blending of CVC words and sight words.

Materials Needed

- Laminated printout of this game (page 2)
- One dice
- Coins to move around
- Some card cut-outs for the sentences which can also be laminated (page 3)

What to do?

- Roll the dice and move forward as many spaces as the dice shows.
- Wherever the player lands, he/she has to read the word. Wherever possible, he/she has to try to act out the word.
- For every correctly read out word, the player gets 10 points.
- If the player gets a six on the dice, then he/she not only moves forward but is entitled to pick a card and read the sentence written on it.
- For every correctly read sentence, the player gets 20 points.
- Whoever scores the maximum points at the finish line is the winner.
- This game can be played by a single player also, but having 4-5 players of the same age will be more fun!
