OCEAN SENSORY BAG



Learning Objectives

- To develop hand-eye co-ordination
- To enhance sensorial development

Materials Needed

- Freezer bag
- Small toys of sea animals
- 1 cup of sand (plain or coloured)
- Bottle of blue body wash, or blue hand soap
- Sea shells
- Small coloured or plain pebbles



What to do?

- Pour all the materials in the bag.
- Add a few drops of body wash.
- Add water to it and seal it tightly.
- Ensure that it doesn't leak, you can tape around the edges.
- Your ocean sensory bag is ready.

What to do for the child:

- Allow the child to help you while filling the bag with materials.
- You can provide a spoon for them to pour the sand.
- Let them shake the bag and observe what happens.

PLAYING TIP:

Allow the child to explore the sensory bag as he discovers and experiences how the objects and the water inside the bag move.
