Flip the pages from right to left.

Materials Needed

- Books having pictures of different family members/Family album.

What to do :

- Provide your child with a book/photo album consisting pictures of family members.
- Encourage your child to flip pages from right to left and further identify the family members.

Role play- Dress up like grandpa/ grandma

Materials Needed

- Saree
- Shirt
- Bindi
- Spectacles
- Tie, etc

What to do :

- Provide different dress up clothes and accessories for children to dress up like grandma, grandpa in saree, shirt tie etc.

Sensory play – Look for pictures of family members.

Materials Needed

- Big tray/bowl
- Sand/rice/crushed paper
- Pictures of family members
- Family album

What to do :

- Hide pictures of family members in sand/rice/crushed paper.
- Encourage your child to look for the pictures of family members in sand/rice/crushed paper and identify them.
- You can even go through a family album and encourage your child to identify the family members.

Let's carry objects from one place to another

Materials Needed

- Different coloured objects like Blocks, ball, any small toy, etc.
- Basket/Big bowl

What to do :

- Place 3-4 objects at different distances(not too far).
- Provide your child with a basket/big bowl and encourage him/her to walk with big steps and small steps to pick the objects kept at different distances and put it into the basket/big bowl that they are carrying.
- Motivate the child to complete the course.
- If your child wishes to do it again you can replace the objects and add some more.

Identify the big ball and colour it.

Materials Needed :

- A4 size paper
- Marker
- Crayons

What to do :

- Provide your child with an A4 size paper with a big and small ball drawn on it.
- Encourage your child to identify the big and small ball.
- Next encourage your child to colour the big ball only.
