## Role Play –Pretend to be helpers

### Materials Required-

- Dress-up clothes to resemble the helpers.
- White shirt for doctors along with doctor set(optional)
- A comb for barber



### How to-

- Provides clothes for children to dress up as doctor/dentist/barber and pretend to be one.
- You can guide and also pretend along with your child
- Encourage your child to use a torch and pretend being a dentist.

## Pouring Activity

### Materials Required:

- Medicine droppers
- Small paper/plastic/steel cup
- Medium size bowl, 3/4<sup>th</sup> filled with water
- Empty bowl



### How to-

- Provide your child with the cups and medicine dropper.
- Encourage him/her to fill the small cup with water and pour it in the empty bowl
- Repeat the same using a medicine dropper.
- You can ask your child the following questions- When do we have medicine?(when we are unwell)  
Who gives us medicine??(doctor

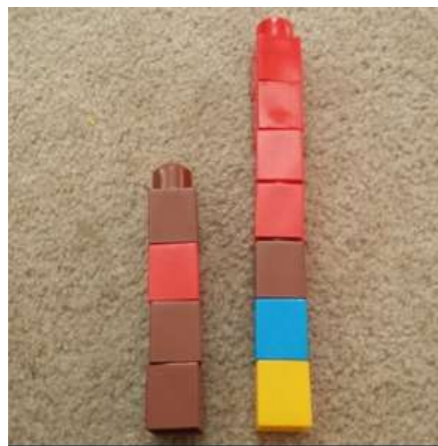
## Block fun

### Materials Required-

- Blocks
- Props of helpers

### How to-

- Encourage your child to use blocks to build tall and short buildings for hospital, road leading to the hospital.
- Provide doctor, dentist props for your child to place in their creation.



## Let's sort tall and short objects

### Materials Required-

- Tall and short objects like - Tall bottle and short bottle, Tall glass and short glass, etc
- 2 trays

### How to-

- Encourage your child to compare all objects and sort objects them as tall and short in the two given trays.
- As your child sorts the objects, encourage him/her to say Tall and Short.



## Up, up and away

### Materials Required-

- Different size balls/newspaper balls made in different sizes

### How to-

- Encourage your child to throw the balls upwards as high as they can and let them attempt to catch them
