## Paper Bag Cow Puppet

### Materials Required:

- Paper Bag
- Pre-cut shapes of 2 horns, 2 ears, 2 hands, tail, body, 2 circles for eyes.
- Black and red marker
- Scissors
- Glue stick



### How to

- The flap side of the paper bag to be the front and the smooth side to be the back of the cow puppet.
- Show the reference picture of the cow to the child and let the child assemble the different parts.
- Help the child only if he/she asks for help.
- Paste the parts together.
- With the markers, draw the eyes, nose and mouth.

## Pattern Making - cccc

### Materials Required:

- A4 sheet with pre-drawn cccc pattern (4 rows)
- crayons

### How to

- Parent to draw the cccc pattern on an A4 sheet (4 rows).
- Child to follow the formation of letter 'c' with crayons.

## Messy Feet Print

### Materials Required:

- 1 big tray
- Orange paint
- A4 Sheet of paper
- Green strips of paper (8-10 in number, around 2 inches in length )
- Water in a tub
- Towel



### How to

- Child to dip feet in a tray of orange paint.
- Now that the feet are messy with paint, child to place feet onto the sheet of paper.
- Let the child end by dipping their feet in a tub of water and then walk on the floor to see their foot prints. This activity works well in outdoor space where they can see their foot prints fade away.
- When the paint is dry. Cut the A4 sheet along the outline.
- Paste green strips of paper on the top.
- Encourage the child to say the name of the object he/she created and also the beginning sound of the word 'carrot'.
