Pre-K
Week 11



Dear Parent,

Kindly ensure that your child completes these offline activities. You can repeat these activities during the week as for children – ‘The more they repeat, the better they learn’.

Sensory Play

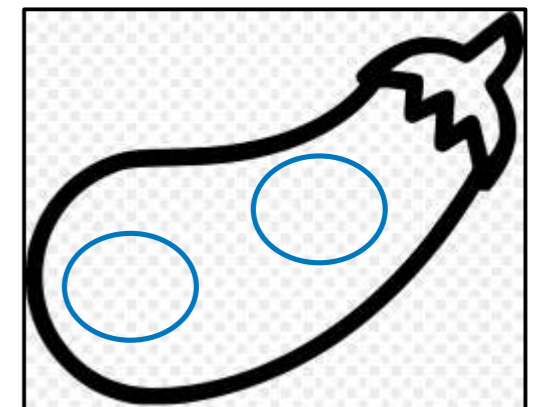
Materials Required:

- Pre-drawn oooo pattern inside an eggplant shape on an A4 sheet
- Playdough

How to

- The parent to give the pre-drawn sheet to the child and ask them to identify the vegetable they see.
- The child to then, roll the playdough thin and long. Encourage the child to use his/her 3 writing fingers
- Encourage the child to place the playdough on the outline of the circle starting from the top and in an anticlockwise direction.
- The child to clean up, once done.

- Tip:** 1. For durability you could laminate the brinjal/eggplant worksheet or put it in a sheet protector.
2. Add texture to the playdough
3. This activity is a pre-writing skill hence encourage repetition.



Role Play

Materials Required:

- Readymade or home-made playdough/ crepe paper fruits and vegetables neatly arranged in trays/ baskets
- Objects starting with /e/ sound like eggs, envelope, eggplant, etc.
- Shopping List
- Pretend money
- Weighing machine, toy or real (optional)
- Paper bags



How to

- Set up a grocery shop that sells fruits/ vegetables and objects starting with 'e' such as eggs, eggplant, envelope, etc.
- Make the vegetables using play dough /crepe paper.
- The child to pretend to play the role of a cashier and/or customer
- Provide your child with shopping baskets, a shopping list and pretend money that has either a 1 or 2 written on it.
All products should be priced as 1 or 2 KLAY rupees.
- Encourage your child to refer to the shopping list while shopping.
- Participate with the child and encourage him/her to use words such as – heavy/light, words with 'e' sound
- Encourage the child to try to listen for the 'e' sound when you speak

Block Play

Materials Required:

- Building Blocks



How to

- Show real objects/ pictures of the letter sound /e/ and encourage the child to make objects like eggs, eggplant, envelope and elephant to reinforce the letter sound.
- If the child still seems interested, show more pictures or real vegetables like potato, onion, cabbage, peas, eggplant, tomato and encourage them to make them with the blocks.
- Talk to the child about the objects/vegetables and encourage them to speak about the colour, taste and textures of the vegetables.
