



ACTIVITIES FOR THE WEEK

Pre-K
Week 13



Dear Parent,

Kindly ensure that your child completes these offline activities. You can repeat these activities during the week as for children – ‘The more they repeat, the better they learn’.



Sorting Time

Materials Required (Any 3 pairs of easily available objects)

- Tall and short glass
- Tall and short plant
- Tall and short bottle
- Tall and short toothbrush (Parent's and Baby toothbrush)
- Tall and short comb (Parent's comb and Baby comb)

How to

- Keep the assorted items within the child's reach.
- Allow the child to explore the objects and name them.
- Ask the child to keep all tall objects on one side of the table and short objects on the other side of the table.
- Allow the child to sort out the objects on his/her own.



Block Play

Materials Required:

- Building Blocks
- Pre-drawn shapes – circle, square, rectangle, triangle and all letters learnt till now (s,a,t,i,p,n,c,k,e,h) on the floor/tabletop or on an A4 sheet

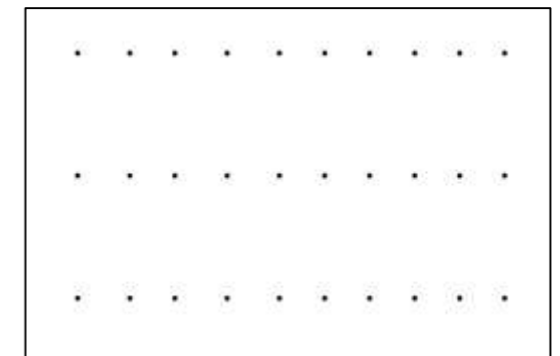
How to

- Encourage your child to name the pre-drawn shapes and letters.
- Allow the child to say the sound of the letters and place the blocks on the letters according to the letter formation.
- Encourage the child to place the blocks on the pre-drawn shapes.
- Let the child revisit and complete the activity, at a later time, if they wish.

Left to Right Progression

Materials Required:

- Pre-drawn A4 sheet with three rows of dotted lines
- Orange crayon
- 1 Ear bud
- Purple and green paint



How to

- The child to join the dots on the first line using an orange crayon and moving their hand from left to right.
- The child to connect the dots on the second line with an ear bud dipped in purple paint.
- The child to connect the dots on the third line with their pointer finger dipped in green paint.

Messy Play

Materials Required:

- Old newspaper spread on a table / tray with an old newspaper lining
- Ball (size should be such that the child can hold it in their palms)
- Paint (any colour)



Mess Alert

How to

- The parent to help the child to spread newspaper or line a tray with an old newspaper
- Encourage the child to dip a ball in any paint of their favourite colour.
- Roll the ball on the newspaper in any direction.
- Encourage the child to paint anything that they desire.
- Help the child only if they wish to seek help.
- Encourage the child to clean up and wash their hands after the activity.
