

ACTIVITIES FOR THE WEEK



Pre-K
Week 15



Dear Parent,

Kindly ensure that your child completes these offline activities. You can repeat these activities during the week as for children – ‘The more they repeat, the better they learn’.

Block Play

Materials Required:

- Building Blocks
- Animal masks made through the week (online and home learning)
- Show pictures of wild animals to the child (lion, monkey, giraffe, snake, zebra, etc.)
- Encourage him/her to make the animals using blocks.
- Ask the child to name the animal and identify its colour.
- Encourage the child to build a jungle or zoo with the blocks and wild animal toys.
- The child may use the animal masks made in the online session to enact the animals and make their sounds
 - Roar like a lion
 - Scratch like a monkey
 - Hiss like a snake



Messy Play

Materials Required:

- A4 sheet/ Drawing sheet
- Water colours
- Water in a bowl
- Ink dropper/ straw/ spoon



Mess Alert

- Talk to the child about the monsoon season and encourage the child to pick up a spoon/ ink dropper/ straw and dip it in paint of any colour.
- The paint should be watery in consistency.
- Let the child explore the material (spoon/dropper/ straw) and instruct the child to start from the top.
- Tilt the sheet a bit and let the paint drip down the sheet. The child may take another colour to paint over the first one.
- Ask the child, what they are painting.
- Encourage independence and help only if the child wishes to be helped.

Shapes Activity

Materials Required:

- Shape cutouts of any coloured chart paper - Triangle, Square, Circle and Rectangle
- Glue
- Drawing sheet/ A4 sheet

How to

- Show the child reference pictures of objects/ things with the letter sound /m/.
- Encourage the child to assemble the shapes and make a mouse or different /m/ sound animals/objects.
- This activity may be repeated with other animals or objects.



Elephant Handprint

Materials Required:

- A drop of black paint (poster colour)
- A drop of white paint (poster colour)
- A4 sheet / Drawing Sheet
- Black Marker Pen/ Sketch pen
- This is a continuation of the Online Activity done on Day 2, where the child had to put a drop of black paint on his/her left hand and a drop of white paint on his/her right hand.
- Rub both hands and see the magical appearance of a new colour – Grey. The child to make the grey handprint on an A4 sheet/ Drawing sheet.
- Show the reference picture of an elephant to the child.
- Let the child explore and draw the eyes, ears, tusks, feet and tail of the elephant.
