- Encourage routines and procedures around pack-up and clean-up.

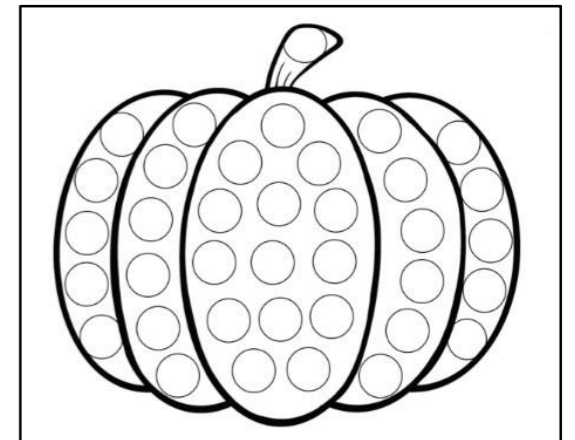
Dear parents,

To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands-on activity suggestions for the week

Orange Pumpkin Activity

Materials Required :

- A pre-drawn pumpkin with dots on an A4 sheet.
- Orange paint
- Small bottle caps/ ear buds



How to

- Allow the child to explore the paint and name the colour.
- Let the child dip the bottle cap/ear bud in the orange paint and colour the letter 'o' inside the pumpkin.
- Encourage the child to name the letter sound /o/ while painting.

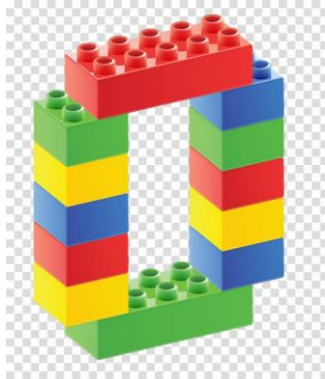
Block Play

Materials Required:

- Building blocks

How to

- Show the reference pictures to the child.
- Let the child explore with the blocks and different colours.
- Child to make letter 'o', number 3 and 3 sea animals like octopus, jelly fish, whale, etc.
- If the child seems interested, let him/her make other numbers like 1 and 2.
- Revisit the activity and let the child build other creatures at a later time.



Number Play

Materials Required:

- Collect 3 objects of the same kind – cars/ toys/ pencils/ dolls/ buttons/ blocks (any 4 easily available objects) and put them in a tray /box/ bag.
- Flash cards for the numbers 1, 2 and 3 (reference picture)

1 2 3

How to

- On a table, the child to place the number cards of 1, 2 and 3 and name them.
- Take out 3 objects of the same kind and place them on the numbers, starting with number 1, then 2 and then finally 3.
- The child to name the objects and count the total number of objects.

Discovery Bottles

Materials Required :

- 2 -3 empty wide- mouthed water bottles/ jars
- Water
- Spoon/scoop
- Orange paint
- Orange pulses (masoor dal)
- Orange flower petals
- Any orange coloured organic, child friendly and sensory material



Mess Alert

- Provide empty water bottles/jars for the child to make discovery bottles.
- Encourage the child to pour water and orange colour paint and mix to see the orange colour water.
- In the second bottle, the child can explore the texture and then pour orange pulses into the bottle using a spoon/ scoop.
- In the third bottle, the child may pour orange coloured flower petals.
- Encourage the child to say the letter sound /o/ during the activity.
