

Note to Parents:

- Organize every activity in neat pouches & trays.
- Ensure easy accessibility for the child to encourage independent learning.
- Allow the child to choose. These activities can be repeated too.

Encourage routines and procedures around pack-up and clean-up.

Language is fun!

Materials Required-

- A straw
- Playdough
- Medium size leaves

How to:

- Provide your child with playdough and ask him/her to pat it on the table/floor.
- Next, encourage your child to place/fix the straw in the playdough.
- Provide your child with some leaves and encourage to pass the leaves through the straw.





Sensory Play

Materials Required-

- Coloured papers of different textures
- A bowl
- A2 sheet
- Glue/glue stick

How to-

- Provide your child with coloured paper and encourage to feel the different textures.
- Let your child tear the paper into bits and collect it in a bowl.
- Next, encourage your child to randomly paste the bits of papers on an A4 sheet to make a colourful collage.

Math fun!

Materials Required-

- Flashcards of numeral 1 and 2
- A basket/big bowl with beads/blocks/small objects

How to-

- Place the number flashcards face down on the table and encourage your child to pick 1 and identify the number on it.
- After identifying the number encourage your child to place the corresponding number of objects next to the flashcard.
- You can repeat the activity for better understanding.
