Day 1

Left to Right Progression

Materials Required:

- A4 sheet (maybe laminated for reuse) with the pattern - uuuu – 4 rows
- Marker pens – 4 different colours of the child's choice

Day 2

OMO Book (if received) – Pg. Nos. 53 and 59.
Follow instructions and complete.

OR

Draw/paste any 4 /d/ sound objects and colour them in your favourite colours.

Note to Parents:

- Organize every activity in neat pouches & trays.
- Ensure easy accessibility to encourage independent learning.
- Allow the child to choose the activities. These can be repeated too
- Encourage routines and procedures around pack-up and clean-up.

Dear parents,

To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands-on activity suggestions for the week

Let's Count till 4

Materials Required :

- A Ziploc bag containing 4 ice cream sticks of varying lengths and colours
- A Ziploc bag containing 4 straws of the same length
- Pre-drawn numbers 1, 2, 3 and 4 on A4 sheets
- Reference pictures of a rectangle, square and triangle

Instructions

- Let the child explore the ice cream sticks/ straws.
- The child to count and place ice cream sticks/ straws near the numbers 1,2,3 and 4.
- The child may also attempt to make a rectangle, square and triangle shapes
- Encourage the child to see how many sticks are being used.
- Let the child make any other different pattern/ shape, they wish to.

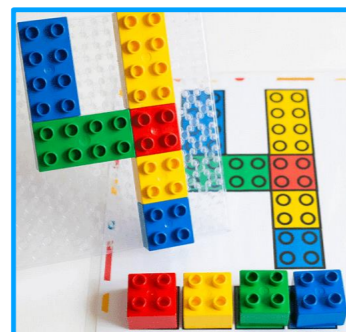
Block Play

Materials Required:

- Building blocks

How to

- Show reference pictures to the child and ask them the name of the animal. Encourage the child to say where the animal lives.
- The child to make any 4 land and water animals with the blocks and count them to make 4.
- Encourage the child to make number 4 using blocks



Playdough Fun

Materials Required:

- Homemade or readymade playdough

How to

- Encourage the child to make the letter 'd', duck, drum with playdough.
- If interested, the child may even attempt to make the other land and water animals like frog, fish and turtle.



Let's Go Fishing

Materials Required :

- Warm/ Cold water (dependent on the day's weather conditions)
- 2 tubs
- A sieve/ net for fishing
- Plastic animal toys/ plastic cutouts like fish, turtle, frog, hippo, crocodile, etc.
- A water mug



Mess Alert

Instructions

- Provide two tubs to the child.
- Encourage the child to pour warm water into the tub, with the help of a mug. The child to predict how many mugs of water would be required to fill the tub.
- Encourage the child to count the mugs of water they are pouring in.
- Place the plastic animal toys/ animal cutouts in the water.
- The child to take out animals with the help of the net/ sieve, name them and place them in the other tub.
