Dear parents,

To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands-on activity suggestions for the week.

Language is Fun!

Materials Required:

- Pictures of farm animals learnt so far

Instructions

- Place pictures of farm animals on the table.
- The parent to point to any animal and encourage the child to make its sound.
- Next, the parent to make the sound of the farm animals 1 by 1 and encourage the child to keep their hand on the corresponding picture.

Stacking!

Materials Required-

- Cups/stackers

How to-

- Provide the child with cups/stacking cups to stack up.
- You can then have some fun as you drop it down and build it up again, together with your child.



Math Fun!

Materials Required-

- Cutouts of shapes – square and triangle
- Chalk/masking tape

How to-

- Provide shape sorters/shape puzzles or cutouts of shapes for your child to explore various shapes and recognize the shape of a square and triangle among them.
- Make a square and a triangle on the floor using a chalk/masking tape and encourage your child to place all the triangle and square cutouts in their corresponding shape.



Let's Discover

Materials Required-

- Ice cream sticks
- Square and triangle drawn on a paper

Instructions

- Draw a square and a triangle on a sheet of paper with the dimensions as that of ice cream sticks.
- Provide the child with ice cream sticks and encourage him/her to place the ice cream sticks on the outline of the shape.



Role Play

Materials Required-

- Blocks
- Farm animal pictures/toys

How to-

- Encourage the child to pretend to be Old Mac Donald who needs to make an enclosure for farm animals. Encourage them to use all the blocks available to make the enclosure (a huge one)
- Once the enclosure is made, the child can then place farm animal toys inside the enclosure built by him/her.
