To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands-on activity suggestions for the week

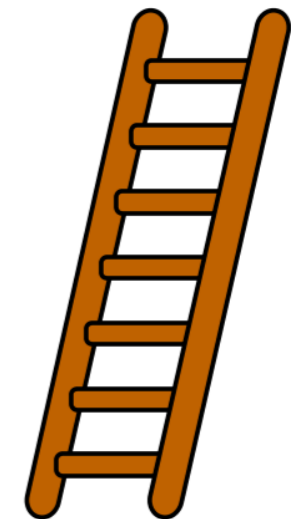
## Let's Make a Ladder

### Materials Required :

- Chart paper ladder with 8 steps (as in reference image)
- Letter sound /l/ pictures like lamp, lion, lock, leaves, lemon, lollypop, etc.

### How to

- Show the reference picture of a ladder to the child.
- Help the child make the ladder with strips of paper.
- The child to identify the number of steps on the ladder.
- Paste pictures of letter sound /l/ on the steps and say the name of the object.

## Playdough Fun

### Materials Required:

- Homemade / readymade playdough
- Reference pictures of creepy crawlies like dragonfly, honeybee, caterpillar, butterfly, etc.

### How to

- Show the reference images to the child.
- Encourage the child to identify the insect.
- Talk about the different body parts of the insect.
- Encourage the child to make the playdough insects, looking at the reference images.



## Block Play

### Materials Required:

- Building Blocks
- Numbers cards – 5,6,7 and 8

### How to

- Encourage the child to identify the numbers, one at a time
- The child to make the block towers looking at the number cards as reference

## My Creepy Crawly Spider

Bring the completed Spider Craft to the online session on Tuesday

### Materials Required :

- 15 Ice Cream sticks
- Glue
- Black and White paint
- Paintbrush
- Paper cutouts of eyes

### Instructions

- Paste the ice cream sticks together as shown in the reference image.
- Paint them black using a paint and brush. Let them dry.
- Stick paper cutouts for eyes.
- Paint the mouth with white paint.
- Write 8 words – mat, pat, cat, hat, sat, bat, fat, rat. (One word on each leg)
