Dear parents,

To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands on activity suggestions for the week.

Language is fun!

Materials Required:

- A ball
- A box
- Book

How to:

- Play simon says game with your child-Simon says keep the ball in the box,Simon says keep the book up on the table,etc
- Next, ask simple questions to your child like where is the ball?
- Encourage the child to answer in complete sentence.

Let's pour

Materials Required-

- Rice/ semolina/ pulses (1 bowl)
- 1 Paper cone/ actual funnel
- 1 plastic Jar/ bottle
- 1 Tray
- 1 Scoop/ spoon

How to-

- Encourage the child to scoop the rice/semolina/pulses into the scoop/ spoon.
- Encourage the child to pour the dry material into the jar/ bottle through a paper cone/ actual funnel.
- Encourage the child to continue even if there is a mess.
- The materials may be saved for further reuse



Block fun!

Materials Required-

- Blocks
- Wild animal toys

How to-

- Provide blocks and the wild animal toys for children
- Encourage the child to build their own jungle or zoo.
- Next, encourage them to make triangles out of the blocks and place the animals inside those triangles.



Role play

Materials Required-

- Green dupatta, leaves, etc (to make a jungle scene)
- Animal masks/head gears/animal dress up

How to-

- Make a jungle scene along with your child
- Provide animal masks, animal head gear, animal dress up to pretend to be animals that stomp, jump, roar.
