To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands-on activity suggestions for the week

## Block Play

### Materials Required :

- Building blocks
- Number card – number 9 (can be made with an old playing card or thick chart paper)

### How to

- Show the no. 9 number card to the child and ask him/her to identify the number.
- Encourage the child to make a block tower with 9 blocks, counting each tower. If the child shows interest, he/she can make block towers of 1 – 8, as well.
- Topple the tower down and build it again with the child.

## Playdough Fun

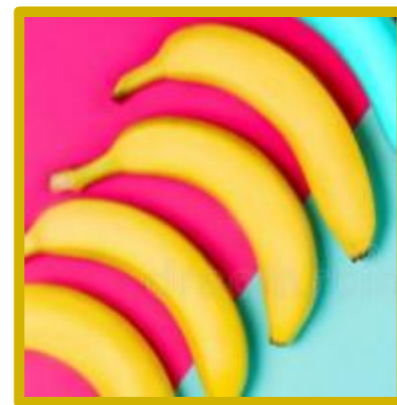
### Materials Required:

- Homemade / readymade playdough
- Reference pictures of letter sound /b/ objects



### How to

- Encourage the child to name some objects with letter sound /b/. Ask them what they would like to make.
- Show reference pictures of the objects and encourage the child to make objects like ball, bell, bat, bee, butterfly, banana, etc.
- Appreciate the child for the efforts made.

## Let's Hop Hop Hop

### Materials Required:

- Number Cards – 1 – 9 (made with old playing cards or thick chart paper)

### How to

- Place the numbers cards 1 – 9, randomly on the floor in an open area.
- The parent to instruct the child to hop like a grasshopper and touch any number card (1 – 9).
- The child to hop, touch the card and come back running. Repeat this exercise with other numbers as well.



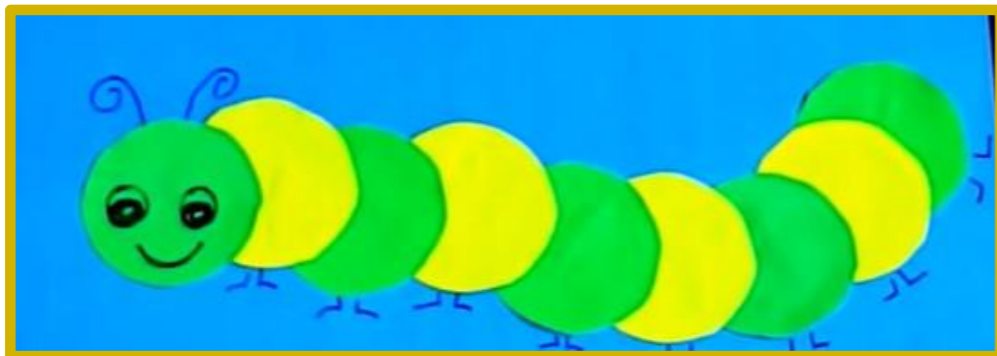
## Caterpillar Craft

### Materials Required:

- 5 green and 5 yellow circle cutouts with 1 – 9 written lightly on 9 of them
- A4 sheet (any colour)
- Black marker pen

### How to

- The child to arrange the green and yellow circle cutouts, alternatively.
- Paste the cutouts in such a way so that they overlap with each other on a sheet of paper.
- Draw eyes, mouth, antennae and legs with a black marker on the 1<sup>st</sup> circle.
- The child to trace numbers 1 – 9 on the remaining circles.

## Left to Right Progression

### Materials Required:

- 2 A4 sheets with pre-draw patterns –
  - mmmm, uuuu,
  - cccc, kkkk, oooo
- Tempera paints/ poster / water colours (any 5 colours)
- Leaf brush (made earlier) / Paint brush
- A4 Sheet

### How to

- The child to pick any 5 colours of his/her choice.
- Encourage the child to trace the patterns in the A4 sheet, in the correct direction and paint using the leaf brush (made earlier) or paint brush.
