Dear parents,

To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands-on activity suggestions for the week.

Role Play

Materials Required :

- Blanket/ Dupatta
- Different types of leaves / Green Paper cutouts in the shapes of leaves (10 -15)

How to

- Let the child pretend and enact the entire butterfly life cycle like –
 - bending and crouching to form an egg
 - crawling to become a caterpillar
 - covering himself/herself in a blanket/ dupatta to become a pupa
 - flapping the blanket/ dupatta and become a butterfly.
- Encourage the child to sing 'The Life of a Butterfly' rhyme.
- Provide different leaves/ cutouts of paper in shape of leaves and encourage the child to pick only 9 leaves.



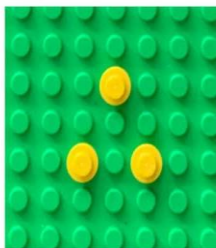

Block Play

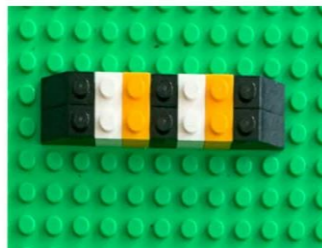
Materials Required:

- Building Blocks
- Show the reference images to the child and let them observe the different stages of the Life Cycle of a Butterfly.
- Now, ask them which stage comes first and so on.
- Encourage the child to arrange blocks of the different stages of the life cycle, in the correct order.

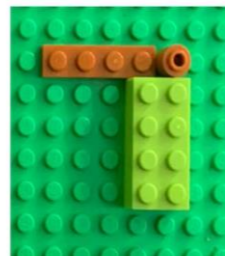
EGGS:

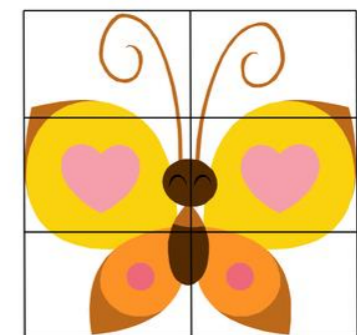
Butterfly Puzzle

Materials Required:

- Tape Art Butterfly Worksheet (Parent to draw 1 vertical and 2 horizontal dotted lines and mark 1- 6 (Made in the online session last week)
- (Kindly refer to the image for the cutting instructions)**
- Pair of child – safe scissors

How to

- The child to observe the butterfly worksheet.
- Encourage the child to cut along the dotted lines.
- Encourage the child to place in the correct sequence to form the full butterfly.
- Now, the child may flap his/her hands like a butterfly flaps its wings.
