Dear parents,

To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands on activity suggestions for the week.

Snip Snip!

Materials Required:

- Child safe scissors
- Newspapers/ magazines with pictures of sea animals

How to:

- Provide old newspapers/magazines for the child to identify the sea animals and cut them using child safe scissors.



Magic Painting

Materials Required-

- An A4 sheet(white)
- A white wax crayon/candle
- Green/red paints(thin consistency)
- A brush

How to-

- Draw some stars on the A4 sheet using a wax crayon/candle.
- Create curiosity as you tell the child that you will create magic as you paint.
- Encourage the child to paint the entire paper to see the stars pop up.

Let's Discover

Materials Required-

- Transparent box/zip lock folders
- Water
- Sea animal cutouts from foam
- Sea shells (optional)
- Sand

How to-

- Provide a transparent box with water and sea animal foam cut outs, sea shells, sand, etc. floating in it for children to explore.



Let's Go Fishing!

Materials Required-

- A big plastic tub/box 3/4th filled with water
- Fish toys/ cutouts of fish from colourful OHP sheets
- A tea/food strainer

How to-

- Fill 3/4th of the tub/box with water and add the fish cutouts to it.
- Provide your child with a strainer and further encourage him/her to go fishing and try to collect as many fish as possible.



Fish Craft

Materials Required-

- A blue A4 sheet
- 4-5 plastic bottle caps
- Green paper
- 4-5 small colourful triangle cutouts

How to-

- Provide the child with a blue A4 sheet and encourage him/her to twist and paste the green paper on it.
- Encourage the child to paste the triangular paper cutout with the bottle cap to resemble the fish
- Allow the child to paste the fish wherever he/she wishes to.
- Refer to the image below.
