To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands on activity suggestions for the week.

## Language is Fun!

### Materials Required:

- Books(with insect pictures)

### How to:

- Encourage the child to flip the pages and identify the insects.
- When you go for a walk with your child encourage the child to identify the insects seen.

## Let's String Beads!

### Materials Required-

- Big beads/pasta
- A piece of string

### How to-

- Provide the child with a string and some beads .
- Encourage the child to string the beads.



## Insect Rescue Time!

### Materials Required-

- Strings
- Tongs and tweezers
- Plastic insects
- Basket

### How to-

- Weave a web in a plastic basket using a cotton thread.
- Place plastic spiders and other insects inside the basket as given in the image.
- Let the child try to take out the insects using tongs. They may even use their fingers to take for this.



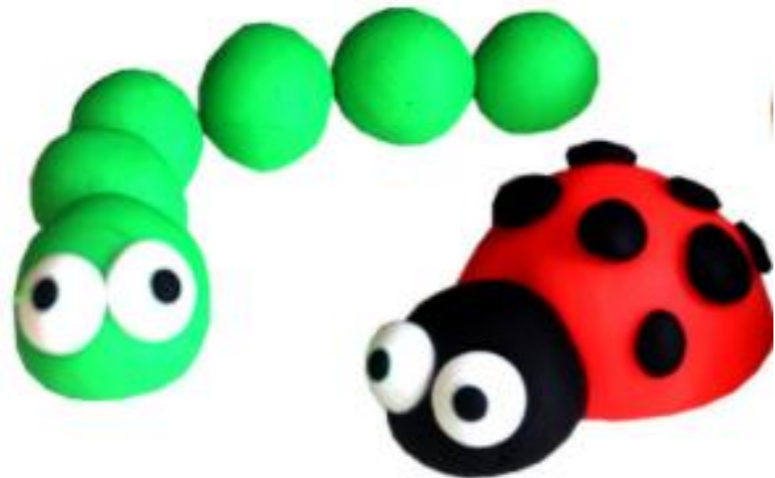
## Playdough Insects

### Materials Required-

- Homemade /readymade playdough
- Reference pictures of insects

### Instructions

- Provide the child with playdough
- Encourage the child to manipulate and roll the playdough to make different insects.





**Worksheet** – Use crayons to colour the box with less insects with green and the box with more insects with blue.

**Conversation tips while doing the worksheet** – Encourage the child to name the sea animals
