Dear parents,

To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands on activity suggestions for the week.

Speak in Complete Sentences



How to:

- Ask your toddler simple questions and encourage him/her to speak in complete sentences.
- This will give him/her a good idea of how sentence construction works and help him/her construct strong and coherent sentences. Ask your child simple things like, “Do you want an orange?” and teach him/her to respond in a full sentence.
- This practice will act as a strong foundation for the future, as he/she will be able to articulate his/her thoughts better.

Pasta Neckpiece

Materials Required-

- A lace/ thick string
- Pasta
- Paints

How to-

- Let the child paint the pasta and keep it aside to dry.
- Encourage the child to lace the painted pasta to complete the pasta neckpiece.



Row Row Row Your Boat

Materials Required-

- 2-3 square pieces of paper (any colour)
- Water in a small tub

How to-

- Encourage the child to colour the papers using crayons.
- Next, help the child make paper boats
- Encourage the child to float the paper boats on the water table and enjoy the boat rides/races



Playdough fun

Materials Required-

- Play dough
- Large Buttons

How to-

- Allow the child to hide the buttons in the play dough and then dig them back out. This process is awesome for strengthening hand muscles!



Block Play

Materials Required-

- Blocks

How to-

- Allow the child to make the sea using blue blocks only.
- Next, encourage the child to place toys or picture cards of water ways like- row boat, motor boat, ship etc.
