Dear parents,

To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands on activity suggestions for the week. Encourage the child to do a minimum of 2 per day.

Let's Read!

How to:

- Transport books

How to:

- Ask your toddler to hold the book right side up and flip 1 page at a time from left to right.
- Encourage the child to identify the different modes of transport and name them (eg- aeroplane, car, bus, etc)
- Ask simple questions like- *Where do you see the plane? Can the car fly up in the sky?*

Let's Peel the Tape!

Materials Required-

- Plastic container
- Colourful Tape

How to-

- Paste some tapes on the plastic container.
- Allow your child to pull the tapes from the plastic container.



Learning Shapes With Toy Cars

Materials Required-

- Black chart paper strips and masking tape (for the track)
- Toy vehicles (car, bus, etc)

How to-

- Make different shape tracks (refer to the image below)
- Encourage your child to move the toy vehicles on the track and identify the shape.



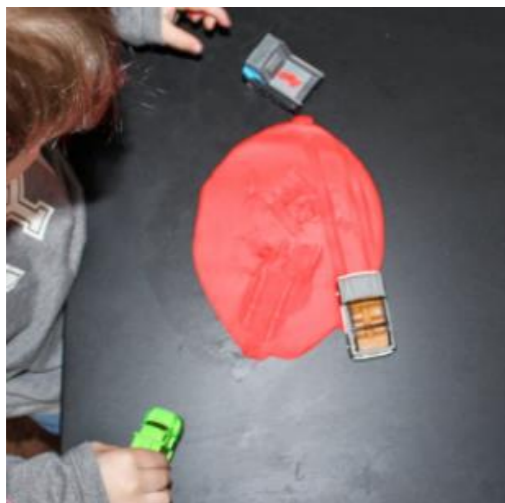
Car Tracks in Playdough

Materials Required-

- Play dough
- Toy vehicles

How to-

- Allow the child to roll and pat the playdough.
- Next, encourage the child to move the toy vehicle on the playdough to make car tracks.
- You can further encourage the child to make a car using playdough.



Block Play

Materials Required-

- Blocks
- Masking tape

How to-

- Encourage the child to make the number 4 using blocks.
- You can make number 4 on the floor using a masking tape and allow the child to place blocks on it.
