

I am very happy to see that the 2nd issue of AU Vibes, our newsletter of the Adamas University, documenting its journey of the July-August of 2022, is being published. I want to mention at the outset that we are meeting through this initiative at a time when globally education is going through a major transformation.

From classroom chalk and talk to a blended mode facilitated by technology, happening digitally, physically and experientially.

From teacher-centric uni-directional education to mentor-driven participative learning.

From largely a theoretical learning to completely projects-based hands-on practical learning in close contact with the industry and the society at large.

From an examination driven education to multifarious assessment driven education leading to specific predetermined outcomes.

From a water-tight discipline driven learning to multidisciplinary and inter-disciplinary learning, where the sciences, the humanities and the commerce are all converging together.

From isolated campuses of education to seamlessly global education going beyond the campus and the country through global collaboration and use of technology.

Travelling through the last six to seven years, we as Team Adamas surely have created some impact in Eastern India, and the various recognitions bear testimony to that. I congratulate you all for the success so far.

But now we need to consolidate and make a big leap ahead. In every sense.

Like, from 4000 to 6000 soon, and 10,000 students on campus by 2030.

From 230 faculty members to 300 soon, and consolidate at 500 quality faculty members, almost all with PhD or major industry experience, within 2030.

From 23 departments in 10 schools to may be around 30 departments in 12 schools by 2030.

From 90% dependence on degree admission revenue to creating one-third revenue from others sources soon, to 50--50 dependence on admissions and research grants & other revenues, like all good universities internationally.

From half the campus productively used, to entire campus fully utilized, every inch.

From 50 teachers and 1500 students staying 24x7 on campus now to 500 teachers and above 7000 students on campus by 2030.

Moving gradually to a highly ranked university under NAAC and NIRF ahead, and ranked among the top



bracket in Asia by QS and The Higher Education ranking.

From only a few Centres of Excellence to more than 20 Centres of Excellence with steady projects and revenues of each by 2030.

From a largely day-time campus today to a fully 24x7 campus in the 120 acres land of ours within a short time. From being a stable and well-paying university today to the highest paying University in East & Northeast of India, and one of the highest in South Asia by 2030.

From being connected to 50 foreign universities, to be in active engagement with 250 universities of the world by 2030, spread across all continents and all major nations.

From being 80-90% placements records to 100% multidimensional placements with high quality organizations in a few years from now.

From being largely employee producing university today to a remarkable university nurturing entrepreneurs, innovators, scientists and creative professionals ahead.

This is the vision I have for this University. And you are that Mission driven team which has to realize this vision and imbibe the spirit of Adamas, and in the process yourself grow into top quality academic leaders of India, with global recognition.

But the vision cannot be realized unless we work daily, based on a firm system and a forward-looking attitude.

projects, etc.

There are major flagship events ahead in the month to come, one by School of Basic and Applied Sciences focusing on sustainable development goals, and BIONEXT by the School of Life Science and Biotechnology and School of Smart Agriculture jointly. The university is looking forward to the same.

Twenty years later, a person remembers largely the things that s/he should have done twenty years ago more than what were actually done. Let us not keep any lament for the future. Let us experience all that we should at this phase of life, participate, engage, share, learn and evolve ourselves for the next phase. 






SOLACS


International Summer Convergence
