KEY CONCEPTS:

The diffusion of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) in the Higher Educational systems as well as in the workplace has made E-leadership a key component of the sets of skills students and young professionals need to learn and master for integrating in the job markets which itself is being transformed by modern industries and technologies. In other words, this digital era is not only raising the demand for ICT specialist and generic skills. It is also changing the way work is carried out and raising the demand for ICT- complementary skills. These are skills that are not related to the capability to use the technology effectively but to carry out the work within the new environment shaped by ICTs. For instance, higher frequency of information made available by ICTs calls for better capability to plan in advance and to adjust quickly.

Hence, for securing a place the digital economy, students and young people, in general, should be able to generate and process complex information; think systematically and critically; take decisions weighing different forms of evidence; ask meaningful questions about different subjects; be adaptable and flexible to new information; be creative; and be able to identify and solve real-world problems, remotely and virtually while collaborating with other partners and collaborators in the other parts of the world. These requirements do create a demand for new skills and increase the importance of installing them in the academic and professional development process of the students. This conference aims at addressing some of these points and providing hands on practice of digital leadership skills to university students. Organized jointly with the Mohammed V University in Rabat, Morocco, and Adamas University in Kolkata, India, the Webinar will invite international speakers both professors and students to interact and exchange perspectives about ways and means for building and enforcing the youth's digital leadership skills for efficiently facing the modern challenges posed by the economic digital transformation.
