Seven months after our country's first coronavirus case and six months following the first nationwide lockdown, lakhs of people remain impoverished, facing hunger, unemployment, and hopelessness.

Operation Hunger continues its unique mission to handdeliver food, provisions, and essential supplies to those who need them most. Our brave young volunteers travel to remote and inaccessible areas, delivering muchneeded relief to impoverished families.

A devastating flood in Bihar has affected more than 82 lakh people, making access to remote areas difficult. Lakhs have lost their homes and livelihoods and are struggling to meet their daily needs

Despite these incredible odds, Operation Hunger has delivered rations and financial assistance to suffering families who have been confined to their homes.

We are glad to report that to date, more than 18,000 families have received essential supplies. In many cases, your contribution helps many families in the community.

Operation Hunger in Bihar

"I hail from a village in Bihar state and my name is Pawan Kumar. I was staying with my wife and three children when the disaster struck.

The Kosi River breached the embankment and the water kept rising in the middle of the night. We left our house when the water rose and it destroyed hundreds of villages and thousands of acres of farmland. The army helped us and brought us back. We had to leave everything we had. Though our lives were saved we couldn't do anything.

We are unable to go back to normal life now as even the paddy fields are inundated. We lost our house, crops, and everything we had. It is a great challenge to get back to normal life after this great disaster. We are also at risk of contracting diseases because of the waterlogging and the existing COVID-19 threat.

It was at this time that we happened to hear about Stewards Association and contacted them. Three days later, we received a month's food rations and some financial assistance as well.

Other suffering families in our village have also received similar help from SAI. We are now convinced that our God is able to meet our future needs as well."

- Our supply teams wear protective gear and ensure adequate social distancing while delivering supplies
- In the event of a known case of COVID-19, we take special precautions while delivering provisions.
