01 Trees, Brand Ambassadors of Our Free Oxygen Campaign

With almost 1,44,000 litres of oxygen consumed in the recovery of one Covid-19 patient, hospitals are appealing Covid patients to plant trees after recovery. Our "Plant Trees for Free Oxygen" Campaign helped recovered patients keep their promises!! Also, with the requirement of 625 square feet of green surface area to produce our daily oxygen needs, trees planted under our campaign are not only helping in strengthening the lungs of Mother Earth but also the livelihoods of marginal farmers while selflessly sustaining all life forms on Earth.

02 Project Hadosiddapura Lake- A Rescue Mission to Save the Lake Under A Constant Threat

36 acres of land of Hadosiddapura lake located in Sarjapur, Bangalore was getting killed by sewage and has now been restored by the massive efforts of lake revivalists. To ensure that the restored lake is conserved and protected from encroachers, SankalpTaru Foundation initiated Project Hadosiddapura to plant more than 10,000 trees along the periphery of the lake. The tree planted under this campaign will help to revive wildlife, enrich biodiversity, stabilize lake catchment area and reverse the impact of the anthropogenic pressure on the biotic components and aquatic species.

03 Voluntary Carbon Tax- A Silver Lining to Carbon Neutral Ladakh

If there was a price on carbon, every country in the world would, once again, have its own bicycle manufacturing industry. But since there is not, we could still figure out how to make up to Mother Nature.

SankalpTaru Foundation partnered with Sonam Wangchuk, Director of Himalayan Institute of Alternatives to start a wonderful initiative of 'Carbon Neutral Ladakh' to offset carbon footprint and mitigate climate change by carrying out tree plantation in the Cold Desert of India. Thousands of trees have been planted as a voluntary tax to Mother Nature since the start of this campaign which are acting as nature's super heroes, converting barren lands of Ladakh into fruit orchards and vegetational assets, conserving groundwater, reversing climate change and helping Ladakhi farmers escape poverty.

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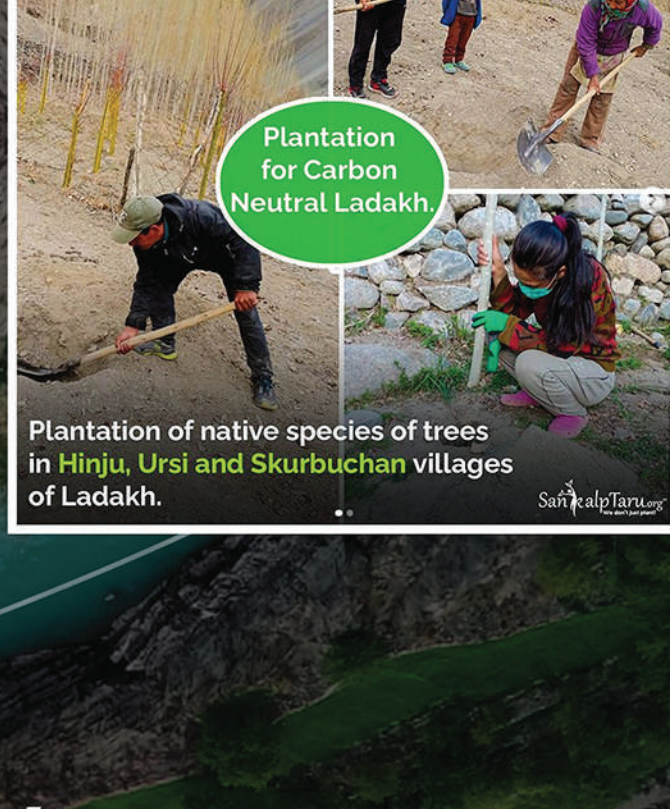
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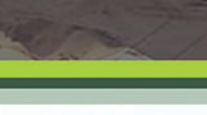

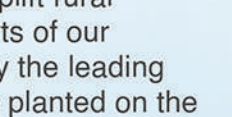


Sungrow Power Supply Co. Ltd. Supports Our Farmer Friend From Haridwar:

Club Mahindra Uplifts Livelihood of Our Women Farmer Beneficiary:

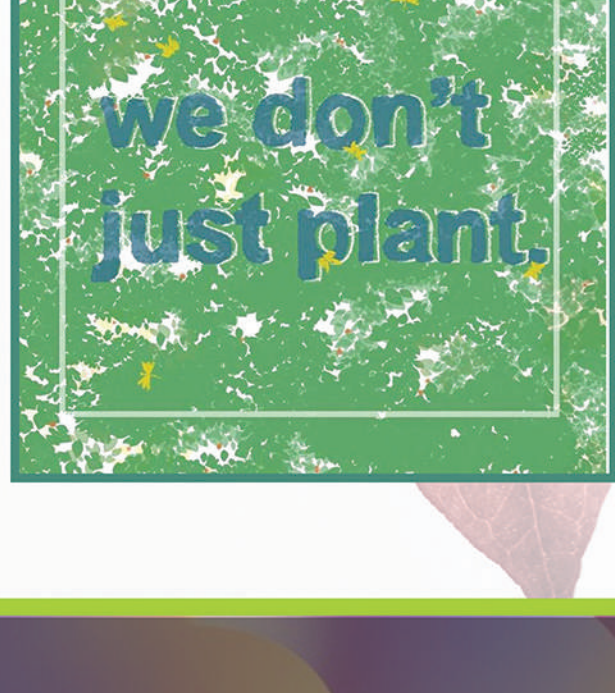
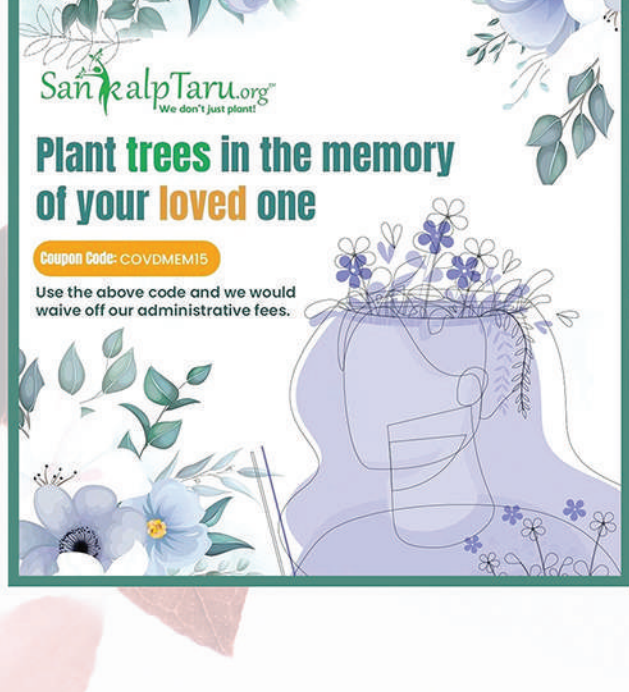
