# Letter from the Founder

Dear Reader

I am glad that we are publishing the Annual Report of SankalpTaru for the Financial Year (FY) 2021-22. It gives me immense pleasure that SankalpTaru operations have gained all time high strength and pace with the support garnered from various corporate partners and individual donors. The financial year marked its start with a deadly Covid third wave. As always SankalpTaru had ensured that its operations across the country run smoothly. We have also extended support to various Covid related medical health support systems.

Through the Covid crisis, SankalpTaru ensured that the support reaches out to the most needy and our operations run smoothly. A helping hand was extended to various candidates who had lost their jobs by onboarding them in team SankalpTaru. Our operations expanded to two more states, Bihar and Arunachal Pradesh and cumulatively, we planted more than 1.5 million trees, generating an economic value of nearly Rs 908 million for 7500 farmers in 26 states and UTs in FY 2021-22.

With our intentions to make all of our Community Barren Land Transformation programs sustainable and revive the concept of living in harmony with nature, we introduced Solar Electrification to our plantation sites, initiated installing Sewage Treatment Plants and strengthened our reliance on drip irrigation systems to encourage more efficient water management practices. We also revamped our online portal for direct farmer produce, GramYumm and launched newer products to maximize the benefit that goes to our farmer beneficiaries.

One of our most powerful Nature Based Solutions to climate change projects, initiated in FY 2021-22 has been our Mangrove Restoration Project, Sundarbans, West Bengal. The project would not only help to create a shield on the shorelines against the natural disasters like Tsunamis but would also help to create a massive carbon sequestration capacity and livelihood opportunities for the coastal communities in the coming future. We have also streamlined various Research & Developmental activities in the domains of Plant Propagation, Circular Economy, Integrated Farming in our Peepal Research Centre, Biharigarh, Uttarakhand. And, also inaugurated the Educational Block of the Research Centre in the memory of Dr. Abdul Kalam as a part of the extensive preparation to start a series of the Farmer Training programs to provide better technical support and interventions to the farmers across the country.

We are eagerly working towards expanding our operations and annual plantation capacities along with our farmer beneficiary bandwidth to accommodate the overwhelming support of the Corporate sponsors and individual donors from all corners of the world. This would help us to better reach out to more impactful places which are in dire need of greenery and support. Way forward, we are committed to bring many more technological innovations closer to the cause which would not only bring more transparency to the whole process but would also make the plantation processes much simpler, more impactful and easily scalable.

We are looking forward to your extended support.










# Sungrow Gave Back to the Planet & its Rural Farmers!

### ONGC is Creating A Self Sustainable Forest in Rajasthan

In the western most part of India, situated near Indo Pak border is located the site of SankalpTaru's most cherished Plantation Project running in Ghotaru which is in the middle of the Thar Desert of Jaisalmer sponsored by one of India's leading Maharatna PSU ONGC.

### Creating a Bio Diverse Forest in the Middle of Thar Desert

Who thought that a hot desert which could barely sustain anything but cactuses could be painted green with thousands of flourishing trees? One of the toughest projects of creating a green oasis in the middle of the undeniably inhospitable ecoregions of Rajasthan, was undertaken by SankalpTaru Foundation in 2016 as a Community Plantation Program in Neembla Village of Thar Desert, Rajasthan. Fast forward to 2021, we see a drip irrigated forest thriving in the middle of the dry Thar Desert supporting regional flora and fauna, and thousands of trees in the otherwise hostile climatic conditions.





### Making Ladakh's Wanla and Temisgam Into Apple Orchards

In August 2015, unusual spells of rains and flash floods caused catastrophic tragedies, sweeping away the livelihoods and houses of many people, leaving them completely devastated with no sources of income to sustain on. With more than 70% of Ladakhis engaged in Agriculture, SankalpTaru decided to bring back their livelihoods through agroforestry by providing them fruit bearing saplings of apples.

The project gradually progressed through a couple of farmer beneficiaries into transforming two of the severely flood affected villages, Wanla and Temisgam of Ladakh, turning them from denuded townlets into profusely abundant apple orchards.

To ensure that the restored lake is conserved and protected from encroachers, Sankalptaru Foundation initiated Project Hadosiddapura to plant more than 10,000 trees along the periphery of the lake.

The tree planted under this campaign will help to revive wildlife, enrich biodiversity, stabilize lake catchment area and reverse the impact of the anthropogenic pressure on the biotic components and aquatic species.

### Unlocking Bhavnam 2.0 Plantation Expedition in Delhi NCR

The extreme heat in the summer seasons on the top of the Aravallis, the expedition of transporting rock movers up the hill to excavate the land and dig holes for tree plantation and maintaining those trees in such rocky and rough terrain has been quite challenging for us. But when we look back from where we started this venture to the beautiful ecosystem that has now been created there, Project Bhavnam of Manesar, Gurugram will always be our most cherished plantation project.

With the same level of passion, we are starting Bhavnam 2.0 in Gurgaon, Haryana and hope to create a lush green forest for the community in the coming years.


### Clifford Chance Executed 'Mission Net Zero' in Molai Forest, Assam

# Launch of Web Series-"We Don't Just Plant!"




We launched the very first episode of our new video interview series "We don't just plant" on this World Environment Day, 5th of June, 2021.


# Launch of Humans of Trees Series







#### Story of Our Green Hero, Sanjeev Gurjar

They say, true heroes are the ones who enter into defence, knock out enemies on the battlefield, and pledge to protect the nation's land for the rest of their lives. But sometimes, true heroes are born in the battlefield of life itself. 18 years old Sanjeev Gurjar lost his father to a tragic road accident. His father Bharat Singh was a farmer beneficiary of Sankalp Taru from Sevkheda, district Alwar, Rajasthan. He had recently entered into agroforestry with the help of our team, which had planted 1300 pomegranate saplings on his farm in April, 2016. But sadly, he could not reap the harvest of his dreams of diversifying his income and affording a better education for his children. His sudden demise turned his eldest son, Sanjeev's life upside down. A single incident took away from Sanjeev his guardian, bread earner and the only source of motivation, for him to pursue his preparations for defence. The 18 months naive pomegranate trees were left untendered. And Sanjeev had no idea how to look after them, since his family had been involved in the traditional farming of mustard seeds and cotton as far as he could remember.

For a grieving son, the challenges that he faced upon entering into farming were huge and threatening but he did not give up. The soldier in him didn't give up! Since then, with the guidance from our onground coordinators, he has managed to harvest 90-100 quintals of pomegranates, earning 4 lacs per annum in the last two years. He is expecting to harvest 200-220 quintals earning 10 lacs per annum with his ongoing yield, thus fulfilling his father's dream. We salute to his impeccable spirit of standing firm, knocking out all the odds and being a true green hero!
